Notes:

1. The number of schools by type of school is based on the governance of schools as at 1 November 2013 excluding independent schools (see note 2 below).
2. The total number of independent schools and the total number of pupils at independent schools has been taken from the Department of Education's 'Schools, Pupils and their Characteristics: January 2013', SFR21/2013, Tables 7a and 7b, date released 12 July 2013.
3. The total number of pupils for local authority maintained schools and for academies is taken from the Summer 2013 School Census which is a snapshot as at 16 May 2013. Data from the Autumn 2013 School Census are not available yet. This column provides the total number of pupils on roll at School Census day. To avoid double counting of pupils who were dual registered, each pupil has only been counted as attending their main school. Please note that where schools have converted to academies since the Summer 2013 Census the number of pupils at their predecessor school have been used.
4. The total number of pupils for pupil referral units is taken from the 2013 Pupil Referral Unit Census which is a snapshot for 17 January 2013.
5. The total number of teachers has been taken from the School Workforce Census which took place in November 2012. Data for 2013 are not available yet. These data include both teachers and teaching assistants. Please note that only information on staffing levels at local authority maintained schools is collected by the local authority as part of this return.
6. There are no free schools open in Croydon at this time.
