Croydon Council works with other local authorities on strategic matters related to the preparation of development plans (both Croydon's and other local authorities'). The Council also works with government agencies to ensure the Croydon Local Plan is aligned with their strategic objectives. Croydon worked with other public sector bodies in preparing the Croydon Local Plan – Strategic Policies, which was highlighted in the Inspector's Report into the plan.
