

POTHOLES

1. The number of potholes reported within your local authority area broken down by financial year 2016/2017, 2017/2018 and 2018 to date.

2016/2017 = 3,693

2017/2018 = 3,791

April 2018 to Dec 2018 = 1,857

2. The minimum depth and width in cm a reported pothole must be in order to be recorded as a pothole by your local authority.

Investigatory level : 20mm for Footway;
40mm for Carriageway

3. The amount of money the local authority has spent - broken down by financial year 2016/2017, 2017/2018 and 2018 to date - on paying compensation to claimants where vehicle damage was caused by potholes/damaged road surfaces.

2016/2017 = 2,692

2017/2018 = 2,699

April 2018 to Dec 2018 = 1,737

5. The amount of money the local authority has spent on repairing potholes within your local authority area broken down by financial year 2016/2017, 2017/2018 and 2018 to date.

2016/2017 = £579,563.66

2017/2018 = £456,117.93

April 2018 to Dec 2018 = £244,304.21
