

55,830 people registered with a Croydon GP have been diagnosed with hypertension, this is 12.7% of the GP register


Since last year, the number of people diagnosed with hypertension has increased by 2,178 people and 0.1 % point

35,966 adults (aged 18+) registered with a Croydon GP have been diagnosed with obesity, this is 10.4% of the GP register


Since last year, the number of adults diagnosed with obesity has increased by 3,333 people and 0.8 % points

Diagnosed Obesity in Croydon GPs QOF, 2022/23, percentage of GP list size aged 18+




Depression

33,262 adults (aged 18+) registered with a Croydon GP have been diagnosed with depression, this is 9.6% of the GP register


Since last year, the number of adults diagnosed with depression has increased by 2,272 people and 0.5 % points

Diagnosed Depression in Croydon GPs QOF, 2022/23, percentage of GP list size aged 18+




Asthma

Since last year, the number of people aged 6+ diagnosed with asthma has increased by 457 people and 0.0 % points


The reporting parameters for asthma changed in 2020/21 and so it is only possible to show trends from this point

Non-Diabetic Hyperglycaemia



Since last year, the number of adults diagnosed with NDH has increased by 2,792 people and 0.7 % points



27,067 adults (aged 17+) registered with a Croydon GP have been diagnosed with diabetes, this is 7.7% of the GP register


Since last year, the number of adults diagnosed with diabetes has increased by 1,125 people and 0.2 % points

13,159 adults (aged 18+) registered with a Croydon GP have been diagnosed with CKD, this is 3.8% of the GP register


Since last year, the number of adults diagnosed with CKD has increased by 1,785 people and 0.4 % points

Diagnosed prevalence of chronic kidney disease (% of all adult patients aged 18+)




Diagnosed Chronic Kidney Disease in Croydon GPs QOF, 2022/23, percentage of GP list size aged 18+
