
# Introduction



# North West: key information

## Population

61,815 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

68% of registered patients living in the North West are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- High proportion of young people (24%)
- Lowest proportion of population with a White British ethnic group (16%)
- Largest proportion of population with an Asian / Asian British ethnic group (30%)
- Largest proportion of population with an 'other' ethnic group (5%)
- High proportion of small areas with high population density. These tend to be within Bensham Manor, the bottom of West Thornton and the west of Norbury & Pollards Hill wards

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of highest deprivation towards the bottom of West Thornton ward.

Life expectancy ranges from 75-82 years (males) and 81-87 years (females).



Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Lowest proportions of disabled residents (13%) and residents aged 66+ who live alone (41%)
- Lowest proportions of patients with a mental health issue (10%) or a high blood pressure (13%)
- Highest proportions of; residents with limited English proficiency (5%), overcrowded households (15%), households in fuel poverty (13%), children in poverty (24%), Year 6 children who are overweight (42%), patients who are a heavy drinker (16%)
- High proportion of economically inactive residents (36%)
- Highest proportion of LSOAs in this area who fall into the 20% 'least healthy' areas of the country (94%) or are classed as high or very high relative risk of housing insecurity (68%)


## Index of Multiple Deprivation

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)




## Population density



# North East: key information

## Population

52,681 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

57% of registered patients living in the North East are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- High proportion of working-age adults (66%)
- Largest proportion of population with a Black / Black British ethnic group (33%)
- Largest proportion of population with a Mixed / Multiple ethnic group (9%)
- Lowest proportion of population with an Asian / Asian British ethnic group (10%)
- High proportion of small areas with high population density. These tend to be within Thornton Heath, scattered around South Norwood and towards Crystal Palace

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of highest deprivation towards the west of Thornton Heath ward.

Life expectancy ranges from 76-82 years (males) and 81-85 years (females).


Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Low proportion of unpaid carers (13%) and households with 1+ disabled residents (26%)
- High proportion of households in fuel poverty (11%)
- Low proportion of economically inactive people (32%)
- High proportion of reception-age children who are overweight
- Highest proportion of patients who are a current smoker (16%)
- High proportion of patients who are a heavy drinker (12%)
- Low proportion of patients with a high blood pressure (13%)


## Index of Multiple Deprivation

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)





## Population density



# Central West: key information

## Population

109,501 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

59% of registered patients living in the Central West are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Lowest proportion of older people (9%) and highest proportion of working-age adults (68%)
- Highest proportion of population with a White Other ethnic group (14%)
- High proportion of population with an Asian / Asian British ethnic group (21%)
- Highest estimated population growth across all age groups
- Highest proportion of small areas with high population density. These tend to be within Addiscombe West, Selhurst and Fairfield wards

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of highest deprivation towards the east Broad Green and Fairfield wards.

Life expectancy ranges from 74-81 years (males) and 77-86 years (females).


Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Lowest proportion of unpaid carers (12%) and households with 1+ disabled residents (26%)
- Highest proportion of residents aged 66+ who live alone (58%)
- High proportion of overcrowded households (13%) and households in fuel poverty (11%)
- Lowest proportion of economically inactive people (31%)
- Highest crime rate (14 crimes per 100 residents)
- High proportion of Year 6 children who are overweight (42%)
- Lowest proportion of patients with a moderate or severe frailty EFI risk (7%)
- High proportion of patients who are a current smoker (15%)

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)



Number of people per square kilometre





# Central East: key information

## Population

61,248 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

59% of registered patients living in the Central East are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Lowest proportion of young people (22%) and high proportion of older people (17%)
- Areas with high population density are within Woodside, the west of Addiscombe East and the very south of Shirley South wards

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of high deprivation towards the bottom of Shirley South, top of Shirley North and top of Woodside wards.

Life expectancy ranges from 74-84 (males) and 82-88 years (females).


Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- High proportion of unpaid carers (15%)
- Low crime rate (6 crimes per 100 residents)
- Low proportion of patients with a moderate or severe frailty EFI risk (8%)
- Low proportion of patients with a mental health issue (11%)


## Index of Multiple Deprivation

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)







# South West: key information

## Population

81,229 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

63% of registered patients living in the South West are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Highest proportion of older people (19%) and lowest proportion of working-age people (58%)
- Highest proportion of population with a White British ethnic group (59%)
- Lowest proportion of population with a Black / Black British ethnic group (10%)
- Low proportions of population with a White Other ethnic group (8%), Mixed / Multiple ethnic group (7%), other ethnic group (2%)
- No small areas with more than 10,000 people per square kilometre

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of high deprivation towards the bottom of Old Coulsdon ward.

Life expectancy ranges from 80-85 years (males) and 82-89 years (females).


Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Lowest proportions of; residents with limited English proficiency (1%), overcrowded households (4%), residents in bad general health (4%, households in fuel poverty (7%), children in poverty (9%), crime rate, children (in both Reception year and Year 6) who are overweight (17% and 30% respectively), patients who are obese (17%) or a smoker (10%)
- Low levels of households with 1 or more disabled resident (26%), residents aged 66+ living alone (41%) and patients who are heavy drinkers (7%)
- Lowest proportion of LSOAs in this area who fall into the 20% most deprived areas of the country (2%) and into the 20% 'least healthy' areas of the country (9%). Only 2% of LSOAs in this area classed as high or very high relative risk of housing insecurity
- High proportion of economically inactive residents (36%)
- Highest proportion of patients with a high blood pressure (15%) and a moderate or severe frailty EFI risk (11%)


## Index of Multiple Deprivation

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)




## Population density



# South East: key information

## Population

42,868 resident population (ONS mid-2024).

83% of registered patients living in the South East are registered with a GP in the same locality.

Compared to other localities of Croydon:

- Highest proportion of young people (25%)
- High proportion of population with a White British ethnic group (56%)
- Lowest proportion of population with an 'other' ethnic group (2%), White Other ethnic group (6%) and Mixed / Multiple ethnic group (6%)
- Low proportion of small areas with high population density. Highest density is within New Addington North wards

## Neighbourhood health

Areas of highest deprivation in the middle of New Addington North and the west of New Addington South wards.

Life expectancy ranges from 75-84 (males) and 79-88 years (females).




- Highest proportion of LSOAs in this area who fall into the 20% most deprived areas of the country
- Highest proportion of children (in Reception year) who are overweight (25%)
- Highest proportion of patients who are obese (23%) or with a mental health issue (15%)


## Index of Multiple Deprivation

2025 decile (where 1 is most deprived and 10 is the least deprived)




## Population density
